## Niagara Centre



Peter Partridge, a valued and long standing member of the Niagara Centre of The Royal Canadian College of Organists passed away suddenly at his home on October 4<sup>th</sup> 2018 to the great dismay of his colleagues. In addition to his activities and support of the centre he was also active at the National level having served as national board chairman, and was the current treasurer of the Canadian Interna-

tional Organ Competition. Born in Kingston he moved to England where he furthered his musical education at the Royal Academy of Music, was music master of Westminster School and served as assistant to the Abbey organist. Returning to Canada in 1964 he became Director of Music at Ridley College where he served for five years. Peter was the Director of Music at St. Paul Street United Church (now Silver Spire) 1970 -97, and has conducted the annual downtown Christmas Carol Service since its inception 27 years ago. As a member of the Niagara Centre of the RCCO he acted as the speaker at a number of our Annual General Meetings regaling us with anecdotes of his time at Westminster, and of the practice organ he donated to the Abbey, and subsequent invitation to dinner with Prince Charles. He and Janet (also a member) have always been very supportive of Niagara Centre activities and Peter will be greatly missed by his fellow members of the Niagara Centre of the RCCO and the city he loved, St. Catharines. Visitation will be held at GEORGE DARTE FUNREAL HOME 585 Carlton St. St. Catharines on Friday, October 26th from 4-8 p.m. There will be a Memorial Service on Saturday October 27th at 11:00 a.m. in Partridge Hall at the First Ontario Performing Arts Centre, 250 St. Paul Street., St.Catharines.
