PARTRIDGE MEMORIAL ORGAN SCHOLARSHIP

The RCCO Niagara Centre Partridge Memorial Organ Scholarship is offered to support those interested in beginning or continuing study of the organ. Applicants of all ages and experience will be given equal consideration. The amount of the scholarship is \$500, plus a free one-year membership to the Niagara Centre for those who are not currently members of the College. This scholarship is offered in memory of Peter M. Partridge, a significant supporter of the arts in Niagara throughout his career and lifetime. Mr. Partridge was an involved member of the RCCO at both the local and national level, an active organist and conductor in Niagara for many years, and an important philanthropist in the arts community locally and abroad.

Application Regulations:

- 1. Application deadline: April 1st and October 1st of each year.
- 2. Applicants who already study with an RCCO Niagara member are eligible to apply.
- 3. Successful applicants who are not residents of the Niagara Region must study with an RCCO Niagara member. Successful applicants who are residents of the Region are not required to study with an RCCO Niagara member, but are encouraged to do so. Regardless, the chosen teacher should be a member of an RCCO centre or AGO chapter.
- 4. Applicants who currently have an organ teacher or have one in contact/consideration may indicate so on the application.
- 5. Applicants may be invited for an audition. Requirements of the audition are detailed in the application section.
- 6. Previous scholarship winners are not currently eligible to apply. The number of scholarships awarded is at the discretion of the Centre.
- 7. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the approved teacher and must be used within one year from the date the scholarship was awarded.
- 8. RCCO Niagara Centre reserves the right to make changes to this scholarship's regulations and application requirements, as well as to cancel the scholarship and demand (in consultation with the instructor) reimbursement of any used portion of the scholarship to the RCCO if the conditions of the award are not fulfilled.
